Facilitator Training is for those who have mastered SharePoint and CorasWorks and now want to help others learn and use SharePoint as a virtual work environment. This type of training is geared more toward the soft skills needed to coach others, consult, and solve collaboration challenges. As a facilitator, you are responsible for the following:

1. Helping new SharePoint users obtain the required accounts for CAC, NMCI, and SharePoint
2. Identify and create appropriate SharePoint permissions for new users
3. Work with Site Administrators to maintain user groups
4. Teach SharePoint and Virtual Work Environment classes, including Basic SharePoint, Site Administrator, and Facilitator training

- o **Teach** - Show others how to perform functions in SharePoint,
- o **Introduce vMCCDC to new users** - Give new users the skills needed to navigate and find information on vMCCDC
